### **MASS. LT. GOVERNOR TIMOTHY P. MURRAY AND KEY LEGISLATORS TO ADDRESS NEED FOR ACCURATE, LIFE-SAVING DETECTION OF PROSTATE CANCER**

**- Key Leaders to Announce Support of the PRIME Act-**

**WHAT:** To recognize prostate cancer as a public health crisis and an urgent regional and national priority, AdMeTech Foundation in cooperation with State House Leaders will host Prostate Cancer Awareness Day at the Massachusetts State House in honor of Father's Day. Prostate cancer is the most common major cancer in Massachusetts' men, with the incidence rate being 7.5% higher than nationally. This year in Massachusetts, 3,800 new cases will be diagnosed and 530 men will die, yet men do not have accurate diagnostic tools for early detection, which is critical to cure cancer and save lives. Highlights of the event include:

- Keynote speaker Lieutenant Governor Timothy P. Murray will present a **proclamation to acknowledge prostate cancer as a major public health issue.**
- **Key legislators – including prostate cancer survivors - will announce their support of the Prostate Research Imaging and Men's Education (PRIME) Act introduced in US Congress and calling for government investment of \$650 million over five years for research and education to improve prostate cancer diagnostics.**
- An exhibit will showcase emerging, cutting-edge advances in research and technologies and demonstrate that advanced imaging can detect prostate cancer missed with standard diagnostic tools.
